Participation Requirements

This class is open to all members of the body of Christ regardless of age, sex, personality, or church affiliation. This group will be fully family integrated, so no need to worry about child care or material that is not age appropriate.

Example of a Typical Question and Objection that will Be Covered in Class

Q: "If God is all-knowing and He knows our future, then how do we ever truly have free will?"

A: God knows the future of what His free-will creatures will choose. Free will does not stop being free just because God knows what will happen. For example, I know that my child will choose to eat chocolate cake over cauliflower. If I were to set them both before her and turned to my wife and knowingly said, "We know which one she will choose, don't we?" knowing this is not taking away the freedom of my child. Likewise, for God to know what a person will choose does not mean that the person has no freedom to

make a choice. It simply means that God knows what the person will choose. This is necessary since God knows all things (1 John 3:20).
